2022 IN REVIEW

As we share our 2022 service counts and accomplishments, may we all be reminded of what a privilege it is, and the joy that comes from, serving in the capacity of helping others. We are engaged in work that changes lives and each of you are touching the lives of people you do not know, nor may never meet. Without your thoughtful and unrelenting support, we cannot do the work we do. Thank you for your belief in our mission. We are so grateful to each of you who invest your time and resources to help us help others.

As we tried our best to "normalize", given COVID seemed to be easing its grip on our lives, our staff noticed a glaring increase in calls related to food, housing, emergency shelter and case management. We continued to do our best to serve everyone we possibly could but – as in many other counties – the need was greater than the resources available. Soaring housing costs, inflation, talk of a recession and the fallout of pandemic recovery created high numbers in crisis. We recognize that now, more than ever, it is incredibly important to partner and collaborate to create a pool of resources that will increase the accessibility to services for low-income households in our area.

Equipped with the knowledge that "we don't have to go at it alone" we worked diligently to form new, and strengthen existing, partnerships. Some examples include:

- Invited SAC Health Dental to provide services to our homeless population who
 receive their daily meal at Family Service.
- Continued access to weekly showers in our parking lot with Refresh N Renew.
- Invited the City of Redlands to complete intakes on our campus to find eligible participants for permanent supportive housing in the Good Nite Inn project.
- Hosted a resource fair with other nonprofit organizations and County entities in the backyard of our Redlands campus.
- Offered on site Stress Management workshops with Citrus Counseling to provide a mental health relief avenue.
- Collaborated with the Pair Team to provide mental health, housing navigation and clinical services to San Bernardino County residents who were facing homelessness and registered with Medi-CAL.

All of these partnerships created an amazing synergy and enhanced our ability to make an even larger impact in the lives of those we serve. We are beyond grateful for our donors, volunteers, grant makers and board members for providing the strong platform which enables us to continue to do this vital work.

THE FIGHT AGAINST HOMELESSNESS

Family Service administers a VERY IMPORTANT Housing Assistance and Advocacy Program with partners including the City of Redlands, City of Yucaipa, San Manuel Band of Mission Indians/Yaamava, Kaiser Permanente and many others.

With the funding provided, we are able to supply emergency rental assistance, move in deposits and motel vouchers for households who have no other shelter options at the time of intake.

In our County, and throughout the State, we are experiencing a very problematic HOUSING ISSUE. Various reports show that the State of California is in a dire housing shortage with over a million home deficit of affordable housing options tailored to low income families. A staggering 78 percent of extremely low income renter households are SEVERELY COST BURDENED. One unanticipated financial setback such as a car repair or an illness can throw the family into a tailspin difficult or impossible to recover from.

Family Service provides solutions to these complex housing issues by providing emergency financial assistance and checks made payable to landlords to STABILIZE the existing crisis and lessen the toxic stress that comes with being in a housing crunch.

VOLUNTEERS - BIGGEST HEARTS EVER!

We love our dedicated volunteers and are thankful to each of them for their assistance in providing HIGH VOLUME services to vulnerable, marginalized, low income and underserved households of the East and Central Valley.

12.583 Family Service counted **12,583 hours of service** performed by over 500 volunteers!

With the talent, time and expertise of our indispensable volunteers, we were able to serve 15,720 nutritious meals to vulnerable populations weekdays in the agency's dining room.

Friends of the Family, an auxiliary group of volunteers led by Lowa Anderson, provided beautiful Easter baskets for **99 children**.

1,237 Volunteers helped pack and distribute **food boxes to 1,237 families** via a drive-thru food box program.

1,199 Family Service administered 1,199 visits to our clothing room for low-income families augmented by volunteers who helped sort and organize contributed clothing.

142.706 The agency collected 142,706 pounds of food from our community.

Volunteers helped match **128 Families for Thanksgiving and 84 families** for Christmas through our Adopt-A-Family Program.

Some **30 low income families** shopped our Holiday room for gifts for their families.

While our gratitude goes to each of you reading this Impact Report – for the important piece you play in the support puzzle that helps enable the vital work Family Service does in the area – each year we recognize an exceptional few. October's celebratory Donor Reception at the beautiful Mission Gables Bowl House attracted a record number of loyal donors and friends. The venue choice and the work of the agency's Friends auxiliary to prepare décor, food and drink resulted in the perfect setting in which to pay tribute to those receiving the Alfred H. Smiley Philanthropic Award and the Answering the Call Award.

The agency's highest honor was created in 2009 and bears the name of an extraordinary visionary and philanthropist who believed strongly in service to others – Alfred H. Smiley. In 1898, Smiley founded what is now known as Family Service with the mission to "Alleviate Proverty, Encourage Self- Sufficiency and Promote the Dignity of All". We hope he is smiling down on us today and reveling in how what he launched 125 years ago has become a multi-service, safety net organization focused on fighting hunger and homelessness in our region. We are betting too; he is pleased by those we have honored in his name whose work has meant so much to Family Service's ongoing success.

The 2022 recipients of the Alfred H. Smiley Philanthropic Award were recognized for their generosity and tireless efforts devoted to the success of the agency's annual signature fundraiser, Dinner in the Grove. Jack and Laura Dangermond were the highlighted recipients as not only significant donors to Family Service, but for graciously hosting the unique event at their incomparable grove property year after year as attendance grows and grows. Char Burgess and Shelli Stockton were also honored with the Alfred H. Smiley Award for their 18-year reign as event co-chairs and the "power players" of the event planning team. With 500 in attendance, Dinner in the Grove 2022 raised more than \$260,000 in vital operating support through ticket sales, sponsorships and a vibrant silent auction. In addition to the funds raised, the event has introduced hundreds of new supporters to what Family Service does and the importance of why we do it.




































COLLABORATIVE PARTNERSHIPS

With the ever-changing needs in the economy led by COVID recovery efforts, intensified housing costs, rising homelessness counts and stretched household budgets, the management team placed an emphasis on creating partnerships that resulted in additional access to comprehensive and much needed services. We are proud to highlight a few of a growing number of vital partnerships:

Sac Heath Dental Services – Once a week, Sac Health Dental services parks their dental equipped truck in front of the Lawton Street campus to provide services to homeless recipients in need of dental care. Their vision statement is "Transforming lives with exceptional healthcare through Christ's hope and healing".



The Pair Team – Family Service provides referrals to the Pair Team for clients we serve who are Med-CAL eligible and who have assigned their Medi-CAL to either Molina or IEHP. Through newer State funding opportunities, this partnership not only provides eligible clients with additional clinician services, but also furnishes Family Service with a layer of financial support that enhances our operating budget.

Step Up / Good Nite Inn Project and The City of Redlands – An enthusiastic partnership between the local Good Nite Inn Project (administered by the City of Redlands and Step Up) identified a need for access points to start to house eligible residents into their long-term supportive housing project. In 2022, Family Service collaborated to host several intake events on our campus where a breakfast audience was largely vested and awaiting housing. We also hosted a Resource Day with the City of Redlands where local nonprofits displayed services with the overall goal of fighting and preventing homelessness in the community.

The Hope Team / Sheriff Outreach – Family Service has open communication with officers from the Hope Team which is a County led effort to provide services to homeless residents throughout the region in a non-punitive way. The collaboration helps to connect officers who are working on the front lines with resources such as food, clothing and motel vouchers to support families who are in dangerous and often unlivable situations.



Redlands Unified School District – Family Service has refreshed its partnership with the Redlands Unified School District via open lines of communication between school counselors and our management team. As an organization, it is an honor to provide food bags for school aged children who are home for holiday breaks but have little or no access to food.

Bishops Storehouse – The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints provide astonishing support to our agency by assisting us with an annual Fall Food Drive in which over 25,000 pounds of food are collected annually. Not only do they assist in this important project, but they also allow us to apply for an in-kind food grant which provides the ability to shop in their Storehouse as we serve large amounts of food daily to the community.

Refresh N Renew – Celebrating five years of shower services, Family Service continues to provide access to Refresh N Renew services each week in conjunction with our Breakfast Program. Thousands of showers have been administered since the start of the service, creating avenues of increased self-esteem and overall wellness for the unhoused population.
